## Wisbech Society Summer Outings

### A day of Guided Tours in Bury St Edmunds

Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> June 2019

The coach leaves Somers Road car park *promptly* at 9.00am arriving in Bury St Edmunds at the Georgian Theatre Royal where we will be provided with tea/coffee and biscuits before a tour of the theatre at 11am. After the theatre visit there will be plenty of time to find lunch before we meet at 2pm on Angel Hill by the war memorial for a guided walking tour of the centre of Bury. We return to the coach at 4.30pm arriving back in Wisbech around 6pm.

The **Theatre Royal** is a National Trust property and was built in 1819. It is said to be one of the most beautiful and intimate theatres in the world and was designed by William Wilkins, the architect who designed the National Gallery. The tour lasting about 75 minutes explores the rich and vibrant history of what is said to be the last surviving example of a Regency playhouse in the country. Have they not heard of the Angles Theatre! ( **National Trust members have free entry to the Theatre on production of a valid membership card**)

In the afternoon members of The Bury Society will take us on a walking tour in which we shall see a variety of curiosities and carvings, many of which would be overlooked by the uninitiated.
